

Rules

1. The Event will be run under British Riding Clubs Competitions Official Rules 2020. It is the Riders' responsibility to familiarise themselves with these rules.
2. Please note the rules for correct Tack and Riders Attire as per BRC Rules 2020. A tack inspection will be carried out for all horses/ponies prior to competing in any class. All hats must be tagged with **AQUA BLUE BRC** tape (available on the day at the secretaries tent).
3. All Horses/Ponies **MUST** have up to date Flu Vaccinations in Line with BEF Rules. Please bring Passports/Flu Certificates to Event. Any Horse/Pony without the correct and valid certificate will be eliminated and not allowed to compete.
4. The Judges' decision is final.
5. All Persons attending the event do so at their own risk. Vale of Arrow Riding Club, its officials and agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss, Damage, injury or illness, howsoever caused arising out of or at this competition.
6. All persons attending shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from, any animal and indemnify the Vale of Arrow Riding Club, Officials, Agents and the venue owners against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and or expense in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 16 must be under adults supervision at all times.
7. Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age and over.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right to amend/alter/cancel any class.
9. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
10. Area 15 Qualifier Teams/Individuals must be declared at least 30 minutes prior to each class commencing.
11. Health, Safety & Welfare, The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
12. It is a condition of entry that all the above rules must be complied with.

BRC QUALIFIER CLASSES

- BRC run a Team FOTH Combined Training and 2 Individual FOTH Combined Training Competitions. All classes have both Senior & Junior sections.
- 2 Team members jump 75cm, each with a different Prelim dressage test and 2 team members jumps 85cm, each with a different Novice dressage test.
- Team members may also enter as an individual class providing the dressage test is different.
- Individuals may enter 2 classes as long as ride different dressage tests.
- Competitors may jump the same height twice.

Class 2 - **BRC Team Qualifier** Combined Training - Prelim /75

BE 100 Dressage 101 (2009) & SJ 85cm

Class 4 - **BRC Team Qualifier** Combined Training - Novice/85
BE 100 Dressage 102 (2010) & SJ 85cm

Class 5 - **BRC Individual Qualifier** Combined Training - Novice/75
BE 100 Dressage 106 (2012) & SJ 75cm

Class 6 - **BRC Individual Qualifier** Combined Training – Prelim/85
BE 90 Dressage 96 (2016) & SJ 85cm

BD Prelim 2 (2016) & SJ 75cm

Class 8 - Non Qualifier Combined Training
BD Novice 24 (2010) & SJ 85cm
