**THIS WILL ONLY RUN IF THE COVID-19 RULES IN WALES CONTINUE TO ALLOW GROUPS OF 30. IF WE HAVE TO CANCEL ANY ENTRY FEES PAID WILL BE REFUNDED.**

This is a fun rally, providing an opportunity to do some flatwork and ride a dressage test, or do some polework/jump a small course, or both. Separate groups ride in either the morning or the afternoon so that we can maximise the numbers attending. Let us know if you are bringing anyone with you (if we know the numbers, we can maximise the number of riders, since we need to keep the total number of people on the site to 30 at all times).

**Options:**

- Flatwork/ Dressage Train and Ride Vicki Clarke and Sandra Fisher
- Polework with Sarah Spencer-Williams
- Show Jumping Training with Sarah Spencer-Williams
- Clear Round jumping

**FORMAT for FLATWORK:** Times will be given to all riders in advance. You will be warmed up for your dressage test by Vicki Clarke, a Professional Accredited BHS Coach, for half an hour with one other rider.

You then ride your chosen test individually in a 40m dressage arena, judged by Sandra Fisher, a qualified dressage judge. She will score your test and give you verbal feedback on how to improve your marks. Score sheets will be available to collect afterwards, but this is not a competition, so the scores will not be posted and there will not be any rosettes.

**FORMAT FOR POLEWORK/JUMPING:** You can choose either polework or the height you want to jump (however low!) and will ride in groups of four for an hour. You will be given a time in advance. The coach will be Sarah Spencer-Williams, a Professional Accredited BHS and BE Coach.

**CLEAR ROUND JUMPING:** The jumping course will be made available for any rider to use at either one or two set times per half day, free of charge. Numbers will be limited by the time available.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS The club has carried out a risk assessment following British Riding Clubs' guidance. By using Howick, where there is lots of space, and by limiting the numbers at the event, we can maintain social distancing. We ask you to do the following please:

- Park leaving plenty of space between you and the next vehicle (ideally 10m)
- Let us know if you are bringing a helper (if we know the numbers, we can maximise the number of riders, since we need to keep the total number of people on the site to 30 at all times)
- Follow the hygiene guidance put in place in the toilet area. Hand sanitiser and wipes will be provided
- Stay at home if you feel unwell on the day – your fee will be refunded in full.
