

RULES

LORRY & VEHICLE PARKING: All Competitors & others must adhere to instructions from the Parking Stewards when given!

- Lorries and Trailers must park with consideration for others. Horses and Ponies must not be left in trailers that have been detached from towing vehicle. Nor should any horse or pony tied to a vehicle/trailer be left unattended.
- **DOGS on a lead at all times**
- **All classes to be run & judged in accordance with BRC Competitions 2019 Official Rules 2019.** It is the competitors responsibility to familiarise themselves with the BRC Rules. These can be downloaded from the BRC website britishridingclubs.org.uk
- **Correct Dress and tack, Please. As per Rule Book**
- It is compulsory to wear Hard Hats to at least the minimum standard as required in the current BRC Rule book (Rule G22.2). Where a hat is a skullcap style, this must be worn with a silk or velvet cover. Failure to comply with the above rule will incur Elimination.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel /alter the event/ class in any way. And cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule.
- All persons attending do so at their own risk. Wye Valley Riding Club, its officials and Agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss, damage, injury or illness howsoever caused, arising out of or at this competition.
- Each Competitor/spectator (or, where applicable, the parent or guardian) shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from, any Animal and indemnify The Wye Valley Riding Club, officials, agents, invitees, and the Showground owners against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and /or expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 18 must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Misuse of whips or spurs will be penalised by Judges
- The Judges' decision is final.
- Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age or over
- Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 30 minutes after the incident together with a deposit of £20.00 returnable only if the objection is sustained. See G14 in BRC Rules Book
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.
- Any competitors who is NOT a member of a British Riding Club must have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- Photographs may be taken for use on our website/Facebook page. If you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the secretary.
