COMPETITION PASSES: From this winters qualifiers and onwards, BRC has introduced a 'competition pass' this will take the place of Pre-Entries. To compete and qualify for BRC championships, all entrants must have a valid club membership AND a valid competition pass, which can be purchased via the BRC Sport80 portal. Any member competing at a qualifier without both club membership and a competition pass will be disqualified.

Substitutions: late simple substitutions may be made at the time the teams are declared.

Complex substitutions must be made by 6.00pm Monday 10th November

A complex substitution is one where teams are re arranged, or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another.

(NO REFUNDS WHATSOEVER WILL BE GIVEN.)

Rules:

This competition is run under current British Riding Clubs rules unless superseded by the rules below. Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. THIS MUST BE PRODUCED WITH THE HORSE FOR INSPECTION BEFORE RIDING AT THE EVENT. ALSO COLLEGE RULES

There is a downloadable flu vac checking spreadsheet available to check the flu vaccination: <u>BRC Downloads | The British Horse Society (bhs.org.uk) under 'Competitions'</u>.

As of Oct 1^{st} 2020 it is compulsory for all horses to be MICROCHIPPED. It is the riders responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and traceable.

HATS MUST BE TO THE CURRENT BRC HANDBOOK STANDARD & TAGGED WITH A BRC/BE/PC PINK HAT TAG in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet with current safety standards. (Horse Event) hat tags are not accepted! There will be a trained official available to do this for you on the day (available at the secretary's office)

Correct Dress please. NO SPURS ALLOWED IN INTRO CLASSES

PLEASE NOTE: Major changes from 2022 including NO sensory hairs to be clipped and NEW whip rules.

LORRY & VEHICLE PARKING: All Competitors & others must adhere to instructions from the Parking Stewards when given! LORRIES & TRAILERS MUST PARK WITH CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS

HORSES & PONIES MUST NOT BE LEFT IN A TRAILER, WHICH HAS BEEN DETACHED, FROM THE TOWING VEHICLE. EACH COMPETITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEARING UP AFTER THEIR HORSE SO PLEASE BRING THE TOOLS YOU NEED FOR THIS PUPOSE.

Competitors MUST NOT muck out vehicles on College premises, nor allow their Horses or Ponies to walk or graze on grass verges at any time. Restricted areas include both top & bottom stable yards & any machinery.

ELIGIBILITY: It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria, the eligibility table can be found here: https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brchandbook/

Horses can only compete once in a team and once as an individual

Horses can only compete in 2 consecutive classes (i.e. Prelim & Novice 0 Points, or Novice & Elementary)

The Organisers reserve the right to cancel /alter the event/ class in any way. And cannot be held responsible for any error in the time/schedule. All persons attending do so at their own risk. Each Competitor /spectator (or, where applicable, the parent or guardian) shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from, any animal and indemnify The Southerndown Riding Club, officials, agents, invitees, and the Showground owners against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and /or expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 16 must be under adult supervision at all times. Misuse of whips or spurs will be penalised by Judges

The Judge's decision is final.

Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age or over

Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 10 minutes of the end of the class concerned together with a deposit of £20.00 returnable only if the objection is sustained.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.

Health Safety & welfare

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials & stewards.
