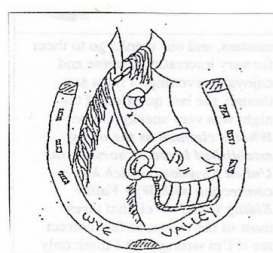

Team GBR win team silver and individual gold at European Championships

The British eventing team sponsored by British Riding Clubs won team silver and individual gold at the CIC** European Championships recently. The individual gold medal winner was none other than Vale of Arrow member and Area 15 sponsored rider Franky Reid-Warrilow riding her own Dolley Whisper. All riders on the team are BRC members. The team was selected from almost 130 applicants and gradually whittled down to the team of six plus two individuals over a two year period while undergoing extensive training, funded by BRC, from team trainers Richard Waygood and Jonathan Chapman.

This is a unique competition of four phases, a team of six dressage test, an individual dressage test, then cross country and finally show jumping. The 2015 championships was hosted by the Netherlands. Britain got off to a flying start in the team championship, leading after the team dressage and maintaining that lead after individual dressage. However some blips on the cross country and very impressive rounds from the German riders saw us drop back to third going into the final show jumping. Clear rounds from Franky and Tyler Cassells with Grandslam from East Cheshire Combined Training Group over a track that caused lots of problems pulled the team up into the silver medal position. Franky was supreme throughout in the individual championship, leading after dressage, going clear cross country inside the time and adding nothing to her score in the showjumping to finish on her dressage score.

This was a very successful championship for Team GBR and extends our record of taking team and individual medals in the last four championships. Grateful thanks go to BRC for their funding of the training programme and to our other sponsors; Equilibrium Products, Luc Childeric Saddles, Mirrors for Training and to the companies that support Team GBR; NAF, Toggi, Land Rover and Griffin Nuumed.
